Ah, romantic love - beautiful and intoxicating, heartbreaking and soul-crushing, often all at the same time. Why do we choose to put ourselves through its emotional wringer? Does love make our lives meaningful? Is love a disguise for our sexual desire, or a trick of biology to make us procreate? Is it all we need? Do we need it at all? If romantic love has a purpose, neither science nor psychology has discovered it yet. But over the course of history, some of our most respected philosophers have put forward some intriguing theories.

Love makes us whole, again. The ancient Greek philosopher Plato explored the idea that we love in order to become complete. In his "Symposium", he wrote about a dinner party, at which Aristophanes, a comic playwright, regales the guests with the following story: humans were once creatures with four arms, four legs, and two faces. One day, they angered the gods, and Zeus sliced them all in two. Since then, every person has been missing half of him or herself. Love is the longing to find a soulmate who'll make us feel whole again, or, at least, that's what Plato believed a drunken comedian would say at a party.

Love lets us escape from our loneliness. According to the Nobel Prize-winning British philosopher Bertrand Russell, we love in order to quench our physical and psychological desires. Humans are designed to procreate, but without the ecstasy of passionate love, sex is unsatisfying. Our fear of the cold, cruel world tempts us to build hard shells to protect and isolate ourselves. Love's delight, intimacy, and warmth helps us overcome our fear of the world, escape our lonely shells, and engage more abundantly in life. Love enriches our whole being, making it the best thing in life.

Love lets us reach beyond ourselves. Let's end on a slightly more positive note. The French philosopher Simone de Beauvoir proposed that love is the desire to integrate with another and that it infuses our lives with meaning. However, she was less concerned with why we love and more interested in how we can love better. She saw that the problem with traditional romantic love is it can be so captivating, that we are tempted to make it our only reason for being. Yet, dependence on another to justify our existence easily leads to boredom and power games. To avoid this trap, Beauvoir advised loving authentically, which is more like a great friendship. Lovers support each other in discovering themselves, reaching beyond themselves, and enriching their lives and the world together.

Though we might never know why we fall in love, we can be certain that it will be an emotional rollercoaster ride. It's scary and exhilarating. It makes us suffer and makes us soar. Maybe we lose ourselves. Maybe we find ourselves. It might be heartbreaking, or it might just be the best thing in life. Will you dare to find out?

Immediately, he realizes what has happened: his right hamstring is completely torn. All eyes in the crowd are on him, watching him collapse to the ground in pain. In spite of starting off strong, he has now lost both the race and his dream.

Within seconds, medical staff members rush to his side. But before they can reach him, Derek slowly and painfully rises to his feet. Somehow, he finds the courage to keep going. Somehow, he finds the strength to finish the race. In tears, he hops toward the finish line. He doesn't even hear the officials trying to stop him. The whole stadium stands and cheers in support. There's only one thing on his mind: finishing the race despite the awful pain. Nothing else matters.

As he keeps moving forward, Derek suddenly feels a familiar arm around him. Derek's father, Jim, has run down from his seat in the stands and has made his way past security guards and officials. No one can stop him from helping his son. With tears in his eyes he says, "You don't have to do this, son! You're already a champion. You've got nothing to prove." "Dad, I have to finish this!" is all that Derek replies. "In that case, my boy, we're going to finish this together!"

Arm in arm and in tears, the Redmonds struggle toward the finish line in one of the greatest moments in Olympic history. Pride, courage, and a father's love carry them through as 65,000 emotional spectators watch in admiration and respect. The people of the world have seen someone fall and rise again—despite the disappointment, despite the pain. They have seen the heart of a champion.

Hallstatt, is a small village that looks like it belongs in a fairy tale - Alpine dwellings, a stone church with a tall tower, nestled in the mountains on a large lake. It's picture-perfect.

However, the mayor of this tiny village has begged tourists to stay away, as up to 10,000 daily visitors swarm its streets in search of the perfect photograph. With a population of 780, Hallstatt has seen a steep rise in visitors from Taiwan, China, Japan, and South Korea after it appeared on popular television shows. Ten years ago it received just 100 visitors a day. Now, Hallstatt receives over 1 million visitors per year.

The village went on to attract yet more attention as rumors circulated that it was the inspiration for the village of Arendelle in the animated Disney film “Frozen”, with its Lutheran church standing in for Elsa’s castle. The Instagrammers and social media influencers soon arrived; today, the hashtag #Hallstatt has been used over 615,000 times on Instagram.

In November last year, a fire burned a significant number of the village’s 16th-century alpine houses to the ground. Before the fire was out, mayor Alexander Scheutz temporarily closed the roads into the village and issued a statement asking tourists to “stay away”. They didn’t heed his advice. The tourists continued to arrive, with smartphones, drones and selfie sticks in tow.

The village earned Unesco World Heritage status in 1997, at a time when it was visited by a manageable stream of walkers and enthusiasts of Bronze Age history; Hallstatt is home to a 7,000-year-old salt mine, the oldest in the world. The boom in tourism has allowed many businesses to stay open throughout the year, and unlike other small Austrian villages it has been able to keep its schools and concert hall going despite a small local population. However, some residents have bemoaned the negative effects of mass tourism. The village has also become prohibitively expensive for locals, as supermarkets and convenience stores prioritise souvenirs over fresh fruit and vegetables. Others have grumbled that tourists have entered their homes without permission. Obviously, Hallstatt is just one of many destinations suffering from so-called “overtourism”.


