Most of us probably take our ability to see for granted, but do you know that over 37 million people around the world are blind? What might surprise you is that 75% of these people do not need to be. Some people are born blind, but many others become blind because of various illnesses or diseases. However, if diagnosed and treated in time, the person's sight can be saved. Unfortunately, some people still become blind because they cannot get proper medical treatment. Over 90% of these cases are found in developing countries where proper facilities and doctors are unavailable.

In the mid-70s, a Houston-based ophthalmologist Dr. David Paton was troubled by what he saw as curable eyes diseases in the developing world going untreated. He came up with a plan to put technology and skills into an airplane and create a "flying eye hospital" that can go wherever it was needed. In addition to providing care for patients in developing countries, Dr. Paton's intention was to help educate the local doctors so that they can carry on the practice.

In 1982, with a grant from USAID (United States Agency for International Development) and private donations, Orbis International was founded. A DC-8 was donated by United Airlines to become the first "Flying Eye Hospital." After **conversion**, the aircraft was put into service to begin Orbis' mission of preventing blindness and treating eye diseases in developing countries.

Today, Orbis has become a well-known international non-profit and non-governmental organization that offers free medical treatment and training for the prevention of blindness. All Orbis members are volunteers, from the more than 400 medical professionals to the 17 volunteer pilots who fly the "Flying Eye Hospital," which is now a DC-10. The new aircraft, which went into service in 1994, is equipped with an operating room, a recovery room, and classrooms where students, usually local physicians, can observe surgeries in the operating room or learn from the

Orbis teaching staff.

Orbis also runs hospital-based programs in several countries, and works with local medical research and health-care organization on blindness prevention and eye disease treatment. To date, it is estimated that over one million people have been treated and over 93,000 healthcare professionals have enhanced their skills through Orbis programs in over 80 countries.

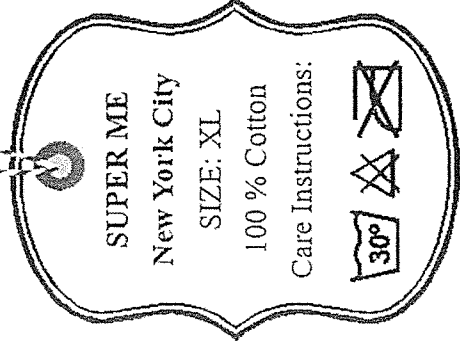

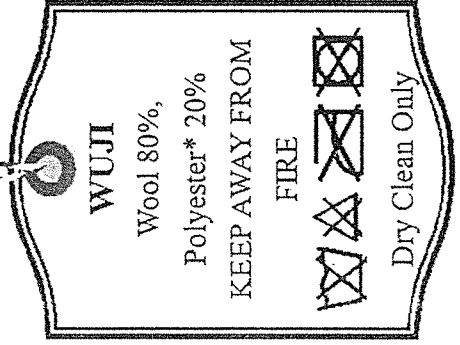

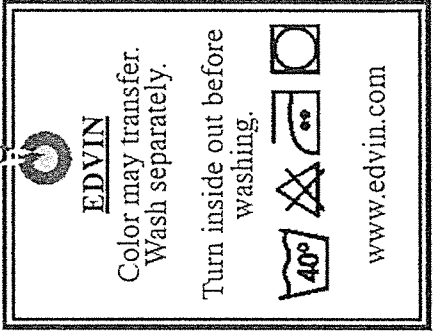
