In the ocean between Hawaii and California, there is a huge collection of ocean plastic known as the Great Pacific Garbage Patch. This collection has pieces of plastic that weigh about 80,000 tons, and most of it is from some equipment used on fishing boats, such as fishing nets. Because of the sun, ocean waves, and temperature changes, these plastics can break down into smaller pieces, which can then be mistaken for food by sea animals. This is harmful not only to sea creatures but also to seafood-eating humans.

Cleaning up the Great Pacific Garbage Patch may seem like a long and expensive task. However, there's a new system that would require only five years and little cost. This system involves a 600-meter-long floating device that sits on the ocean's surface. Moved by the wind and waves, it gathers and catches ocean garbage so that it can be loaded onto boats and taken to land for recycling.

The system was created by 24-year-old Dutch inventor Boyan Slat. Slat began thinking of ways to clean up ocean garbage at the age of 16, during a diving trip in Greece, where he said he himself saw more plastic than fish.

The Earth may be over 4.5 billion years old, but it can still surprise us. Here are some amazing geography facts that will enable you to see the world in a new way.

Antarctica(南極)

When you hear the word desert, you might think of Sahara Desert, where there are sand and camels. However, a desert is officially defined as an area that usually has less than 250mm of rain in a year.

Antarctica is a large land mainly made of water, but the water is locked in ice. So, with its yearly rainfall at about only 170mm, Antarctica can easily be defined as a desert. Besides, this continent(大陸)is not owned by any country. It is governed by a group of nations in a special international partnership. In fact, it is a place for peace and science.

The Dead Sea

The surface of the Dead Sea is 430.5m below sea level(海平面), making its shores the lowest land-based elevation(陸地海拔) on Earth. However, it is disappearing before our eyes. It once covered an area of almost 1000km², but it now only reaches about 650 km². Dams(水壩) which were built stop the flow of water into the lake. Besides, factories pump water out to process minerals, lowering the water level. All of these are shrinking the Dead Sea.


Russia

The Appalachian mountains and Himalayan mountains




