The flying fish season kicks off in March on Taiwan's outlying island, Orchid Island. This indigenous festival has also attracted plentiful tourists to the Orchid Island over the years. However, the Tao people's traditional practices __31.__ a variety of traditions and taboos. To preserve the local culture, the local organization has produced guidelines for tourists to keep them from violating the tribal __32.__ on the island.

For example, tourists should not randomly touch the fishing boats local people use to catch fish. __33.__ with more than a dozen types of wood and adorned with beautiful patterns in bright colors, the fishing boats always attract tourists to take pictures with them. Yet touching the fishing boats without __34.__ will bring bad luck to fishermen. It is also not allowed to enter the backyard of houses where local residents hang and dry their flying fish. Born in 1910, Sendler began helping Jews as early as 1939, after the Germans invaded Poland. At first, she __41.__ birth documents for over 3,000 Jewish families, but she later joined the Żegota, the underground Polish resistance organization.

In 1943, Sendler became head of Żegota's children's department and __42.__ special access to the Warsaw Ghetto, granted to Social Welfare Department workers to conduct inspections for disease, to set up a rescue operation. She began secretly transporting babies out of the Ghetto by hiding them in an ambulance with a false bottom or in baskets, coffins, and even potato __43.__.

Once the children were out of the ghetto, Sendler arranged for them to be given false identities and placed them with Polish families or in __44.__. However, she never gave up hope that, after the war, the children might find their families and resume their Jewish identities. In hopes of that, Sendler kept lists of each child's real name. In the wrong hands, these documents would have been fatal to Sendler, the others in her network, and to the children they saved; to protect them, Sendler __45.__ the lists in jars and buried them. Only she knew where the information lay, waiting for the day she could safely dig them up again.

After rescuing over 2,500 children, Sendler was __46.__ by the Gestapo, tortured and sentenced to death. Fortunately, Żegota was able to bribe the German guards as she was on her way to __47.__. Now it was Sendler's turn to be __48.__ to safety. Sendler was forced to live in hiding for the remainder of the war, although she continued her work for Żegota under a false name.

After the war was over, Sendler and her __49.__ gathered the records with the details about all of the children that had been placed in hiding, but almost all of their parents had been killed in the death camp or were listed among the missing.

Sendler passed away in 2008, but today, her story of __50.__ stands as one of the great examples of heroism during the second World War — even if she never considered herself a hero. Sendler once said. "You see a man drowning, you must try to save him even if you cannot swim."

Believe it or not, Uber Eats and Foodpanda are not pioneers in food home delivery. In fact, __51.__ Dabbawalas, which means lunch box delivery people in Hindi, are an important part of the Indian society, especially in Mumbai, because most Mumbai residents live in the suburbs and have to commute long distances to work every day. This one-of-a-kind network of delivery people brings home-cooked lunches from an office worker's home to their workplace. Generally, __52.__ However, they manage to deliver around 200,000 meals every day in Mumbai on foot or by bicycle.

Most Indians prefer to eat food prepared at home because it's done to their personal taste, and they're sure it will be clean. In the morning, a dabbawala goes to each worker's home and picks up their lunch box. Then, __53.__ The delivery system is very well organized and it can achieve a high level of efficiency. 

Totem poles in North America are poles or posts carved with symbols or figures by Indigenous peoples of the Northwest Coast. Carved from large, straight trees and painted vibrant colors, the totem poles are not just unique works of art. The coastal peoples have long passed on knowledge from generation to generation through oral traditions, and totem poles were the traditional way of telling the story of an individual family.



The totem pole can be particularly grouped into specific categories, depending on its location and the occasion for which it was carved. **Welcome poles** were traditionally placed on village beachfronts to greet visitors arriving by canoe. Inside the homes of high-ranking chiefs is where **house poles** were found. The family's history was meticulously carved into each pole and maintained with much attention. Generally placed along the back or front walls of a house, house poles also helped to support the main beam of the roof.

Memorial poles stood in front of a house. They were built in memory of a deceased chief or a high-ranking family member. The poles showed the person's accomplishments or family history. Mortuary poles were also <u>erected</u> to honor the dead, but they differed from memorial poles, having a burial box placed at the top of the pole. Inside the burial box were the remains of the deceased.

While many of these poles can still be found in various locations on the west coast of North America, there is one pole that can now only be found in a museum—the shame pole. Traditionally, shame poles were carved for a chief to embarrass and ridicule another who had done something wrong. Once the wrong was made right, the pole was taken down.

Totem poles are important expressions of specific Indigenous cultures. Despite the threats posed by cultural and political invasion of colonial forces, the art of totem pole carving has survived. Indigenous carvers continue to carve totems as symbols of their cultural pride and family relationship.
