Born in 1910, Sendler began helping Jews as early as 1939, after the Germans invaded Poland. At first, she \_\_41.\_\_ birth documents for over 3,000 Jewish families, but she later joined the Żegota, the underground Polish resistance organization.

In 1943, Sendler became head of Żegota's children's department and \_\_42.\_\_ special access to the Warsaw Ghetto, granted to Social Welfare Department workers to conduct inspections for disease, to set up a rescue operation. She began secretly transporting babies out of the Ghetto by hiding them in an ambulance with a false bottom or in baskets, coffins, and even potato \_\_43.\_\_.

Once the children were out of the ghetto, Sendler arranged for them to be given false identities and placed them with Polish families or in \_\_44.\_\_. However, she never gave up hope that, after the war, the children might find their families and resume their Jewish identities. In hopes of that, Sendler kept lists of each child's real name. In the wrong hands, these documents would have been fatal to Sendler, the others in her network, and to the children they saved; to protect them, Sendler \_\_45.\_\_ the lists in jars and buried them. Only she knew where the information lay, waiting for the day she could safely dig them up again.

After rescuing over 2,500 children, Sendler was \_\_46.\_\_ by the Gestapo, tortured and sentenced to death. 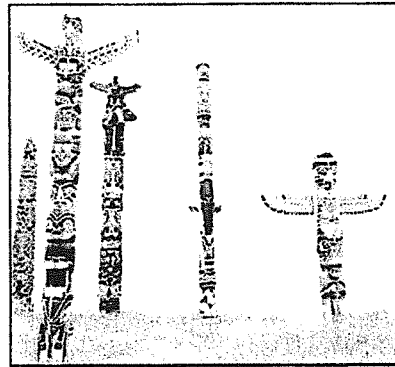

Totem poles in North America are poles or posts carved with symbols or figures by Indigenous peoples of the Northwest Coast. Carved from large, straight trees and painted vibrant colors, the totem poles are not just unique works of art. The coastal peoples have long passed on knowledge from generation to generation through oral traditions, and totem poles were the traditional way of telling the story of an individual family.



The totem pole can be particularly grouped into specific categories, depending on its location and the occasion for which it was carved. **Welcome poles** were traditionally placed on village beachfronts to greet visitors arriving by canoe. Inside the homes of high-ranking chiefs is where **house poles** were found. The family's history was meticulously carved into each pole and maintained with much attention. Generally placed along the back or front walls of a house, house poles also helped to support the main beam of the roof.

**Memorial poles** stood in front of a house. They were built in memory of a deceased chief or a high-ranking family member. The poles showed the person's accomplishments or family history. **Mortuary poles** were also erected to honor the dead, but they differed from memorial poles, having a burial box placed at the top of the pole. Inside the burial box were the remains of the deceased.

While many of these poles can still be found in various locations on the west coast of North America, there is one pole that can now only be found in a museum—the **shame pole**. Traditionally, shame poles were carved for a chief to embarrass and ridicule another who had done something wrong. Once the wrong was made right, the pole was taken down.

Totem poles are important expressions of specific Indigenous cultures. Despite the threats posed by cultural and political invasion of colonial forces, the art of totem pole carving has survived. Indigenous carvers continue to carve totems as symbols of their cultural pride and family relationship.
