Just add hot water, and wait for three to five minutes, a piping hot bowl of savory noodles is ready! Instant noodles are one of favorite food for Taiwanese, as they are cheap and easy to make. However, a shipment from Vietnam and a separate and unrelated shipment from Japan were seized at the border when the FDA found that the shipped instant noodles contained an alarming amount of pesticide---ethylene oxide.(環氧乙烷)

Ethylene oxide, a widely used industrial chemical, is not allowed to be added in foods in Taiwan, since eating it regularly could increase the risk of cancer and damage the nerves located by the brain and spinal cord. The shipment of instant noodles from Japan had over 0.2mg/kg of ethylene oxide detected, and seasoning packs (調味包)in the instant noodles from Vietnam were detected to have almost double the amount of ethylene oxide in Japanese instant noodles.

Those imported food items that fail to pass Taiwan's regulations are either destroyed or are sent back to the countries of origin. In spite of that, over the past few months, there have been still a number of instant noodles imported from Vietnam and Japan that have failed the customs check. As one specific import company is responsible for about half of the failed checks from Vietnam, the FDA is now checking every single shipment of instant noodles this company brings in. Meanwhile, to deal with the pesticide(殺蟲劑) found in Japanese shipments, the government significantly increases the percent of imported instant noodles checked.
