School bullies are students who treat others badly by making mean remarks or posing physical threats to their fellow students. They have existed long before and most people report having seen or experienced such hurtful treatment at some point in their school life. However, a different kind of bullying is on the rise, and it doesn't only happen offline. Cyberbullying, as the term suggests, is a form of bullying that takes place online. Via sending mean and embarrassing messages, cyberbullies can manipulate their targets all the time, even when they are off the school. Victims often find themselves nowhere to hide. Changing screen names and deleting accounts won't help much, because cyberbullies can often track down the victims quickly by following the footprints they have left on the Internet. In some extreme cases, the bullied even end their lives in order to get rid of the unbearable pain.

Although there are no quick measures to stop cyberbullying, there are some things we can do when we discover a sign of cyberbullying. First, don't participate in it. Sharing or forwarding messages that hurt one's feelings only makes things worse. The

best solution is to stay away from discussions that bully someone. It is true that we may sometimes feel pressure not to join such discussions, but we can still turn away from it by standing in the victim's shoe. Second, report it. Find the person in charge of the website and tell him/her about the situation. If this does not help, tell someone that we trust so she/he can take further action. Third, show support for the bullied. If encouraging the victim in person is not possible, try to leave comments that show our solidarity on the website. Some users may find out our intention and join us to change the worsening situation. We can't deny that cyberbullying isn't a problem that can be solved in just a short time. We can, however, reduce its negative influence as long as we are more aware of what we do on the Internet.

Irena Sendler was a Polish social worker who is known _____³⁶ her heroic efforts in saving Jewish children during the Holocaust. She was born on February 15, 1910, in Otwock, a small town near Warsaw, Poland.

During World War II, Sendler worked for the Polish Underground Resistance and the Żegota organization, which was a secret organization that helped Jews in Nazi-occupied Poland. She was in charge of the children's division, _____³⁷ focused on rescuing Jewish children from the Warsaw Ghetto and placing them in safe homes.

Sendler and her team of volunteers _____³⁸ approximately 2,500 Jewish children out of the ghetto, placing them in convents, orphanages, and with non-Jewish families. She recorded the children's real names, along with their new _____³⁹, and buried the lists in jars in order to keep them safe.

_____ 40 _____, Sendler was eventually captured by the Gestapo in 1943 and was sentenced to death. However, members of Zegota were able to bribe a German officer and secure her release, and Sendler went into hiding for the rest of the war.

After the war, Sendler retrieved the jars _____ 41 _____ the names of the children she had saved, hoping to reunite them with their families. Sadly, many of the children's parents _____ 42 _____ in the Holocaust, and so Sendler worked to find new homes for them. After the war, Sendler was suppressed by the Polish communist government, and her story was _____ 43 _____ widely known _____ 43 _____ many years later.

In 1965, Sendler was recognized by Yad Vashem, the Holocaust Martyrs' and Heroes' Remembrance Authority in Israel, as Righteous Among the Nations for her heroic efforts during the war. She died on May 12, 2008, in Warsaw, Poland, at the age of 98

Food delivery can be a high-risk job. Delivery people often rush through traffic in order to make as many deliveries as they can and earn more money. This is certainly the case in Taiwan, where the roads are filled with scooters. A tragedy occurred in early October 2019, when a 29-year-old foodpanda delivery driver crashed his scooter into a truck in Taoyuan. Three days later, another driver, this time working for Uber Eats, died when his scooter was hit by a car in Taipei. According to official reports, both companies waited before reporting the deaths to the authorities. Furthermore, the two companies had hired the drivers as independent contractors, which means the drivers did not have the right to receive labor insurance or other benefits.

After further examination, the Ministry of Labor said that the two firms should offer insurance and other benefits to their delivery people, since they were indeed the employers of the drivers, according to Taiwan's structure of labor management. Foodpanda denied the claim, while Uber Eats did not make any comment about it.

However, the latter did state that it would give money to the deceased* driver's family, and that the amount would be greater than that typically provided by labor insurance.

In the first two weeks of October 2019 alone, there were thirty traffic accidents involving food delivery workers in Taipei City, according to the city's police department. All of the delivery people in these cases were riding scooters.
