- With stores at every corner selling all sorts of seasonal and artisanal tea, Taiwan is a nation of people that loves their drinks. This habit of buying drinks on the go, however, has created a lot of plastic waste. In December 2022, Taipei City banned all beverage sellers from using single-use plastic cups. New Taipei City followed in Taipei City’s footsteps, banning single-use plastic cups in May 2023. Starting from Oct. 1, Tainan City will also be putting a similar ban in place. Thousands of beverage shops in Tainan have been informed about the upcoming policy, and staff members have been sent to inform market food stall owners of the new rules as well.
- Shops in Taipei and New Taipei have chosen to use paper cups, previously used for hot drinks, instead of plastic. Even before the Tainan ban was announced, many stores have already made the change to paper. In addition to paper, the Tainan City Government Environmental Protection Bureau has also suggested sellers consider switching to cups made of plant fibers such as sugar cane, straw, or rice. Mostly, though, there is a push towards using reusable cups. For example, many beverage stores in Taipei offer a discount to further encourage customers to bring their own cups.
- This ban is made in an effort to curtail the number of plastic cups used by the Taiwanese public; the Tainan bureau believes that this will prevent about 160 million plastic cups from being used and thrown away per year. Sellers that do not follow these new rules may be fined between NT1200 and NT6000. The ultimate goal is to stop the use of all single-use plastic cups across the nation by 2024.
