In 2017, the "Me Too" movement spread around the world. The movement began as a social media 46 against sexual assault. Many celebrities showed 47 the movement by displaying "#metoo" on their Twitter accounts. This social media movement was meant to show just how many women had been affected by violence and 48. While people in some countries successfully worked to 49 sexual harassment* in their workplaces, it has been hard for others. It tells the story of a 12-year-old boy named Huckleberry Finn, who had been adopted by and was living with the Widow Douglas and her sister Miss Watson when his alcoholic father showed up and kidnapped him. Physically abused by his father, Huck escaped from him and arrived at Jackson's Island, where he came across Miss Watson's black slave, Jim, who ran away after overhearing that Miss Watson was going to sell him. Together, they set out on a journey on the Mississippi River.

The novel talks about the idea of freedom from different points of view. Both Huck and Jim want to be free, but they define freedom

differently. When Huck lived with the Widow Douglas and Miss Watson, he had to go to school and learn proper manners. These social rules suffocated Huck, and thus he imagined that freedom meant being able to live without their restrictions. By contrast, as a slave working for Miss Watson, Jim was always reminded that he was another person's property. Therefore, to him, freedom meant finally earning enough money to reunite with his family.
