Emojis have become a significant part of our daily communication, especially in messages and on social media. There are now thousands of emojis, and the number keeps growing each year. However, with so many new emojis, some people are confused about their meanings.

One emoji that has caused a lot of confusion is the folded hands emoji. Many people use it to represent prayer, but some think it looks like a high five – the gesture when two people raise their hands and slap them together. A Twitter user named Tristan said, "My brother asked me if this emoji is prayer hands or a high five, and I couldn't stop thinking about it."

The debate has even reached popular TV shows. The Twitter account for the show *Broad City* posted, "We just found out this emoji is actually a high five, but we're still going to use it as prayer hands, sorry."

However, experts say the emoji was meant to show a person with their hands folded in prayer, not as a high five. Keith Broni, an emoji researcher at Emojipedia, explained that the emoji was originally designed to show a person with their hands folded, head bowed, and eyes closed. When Apple introduced the emoji, they removed the person's body and just showed the hands.

At first, Apple's emoji had yellow lines behind the hands, which some people thought looked like the rays of light from a high five. But in 2015, Apple removed these lines, making the meaning clearer. Despite this, some people still use the emoji as a high five, usually in jokes or to discuss the confusion around it.

In different cultures, the emoji has other meanings. In India and some parts of Asia, it is used for the greeting "namaste" or to say "thank you" or ask for forgiveness. So, while the emoji can be used for prayer, thanks, or a high five, its original meaning is folded hands in prayer.

Singapore Airlines has announced a significant investment of S\$1.1 billion (US\$835.5 million) to upgrade the cabins of its 41 Airbus A350-900 long-haul and ultra-long-range aircraft. This initiative aims to optimize passengers' experience, particularly on the airline's seven A350-900ULR aircraft that service the longest routes, including those between Singapore and the United States.

The new upgrades will introduce a first-class cabin, described as "plush" and "luxurious," although specific details about the design and seating have not been disclosed. Business class will also see improvements, featuring designs that promise increased privacy, comfort, and convenience, including the addition of privacy doors for each seat, as suggested in a promotional video.

Furthermore, Singapore Airlines plans to refresh the interiors of its premium economy and economy cabins, along with an upgrade to the KrisWorld inflight entertainment system, which will offer enhanced personalization and a wider selection of lifestyle options for passengers across all classes.

The first reconstructed Airbus A350-900 is set to enter service in the second quarter of 2025, featuring 42 business-class seats, 24 premium-economy seats, and 192 economy seats. Following this, the first A350-900ULR variant will be ready by the first quarter of 2027, equipped with four first-class seats, 70 business-class seats, and 58 premium-economy seats. The entire renovation project is expected to be completed by the end of 2030.

On Thursday, October 25th, Taipei authorities arrested a married couple, Liu and Chang, for illegally reselling tickets to Jay Chou's upcoming concerts at the Taipei Dome. These concerts, set for December 5th to 8th, created huge demand, with all 150,000 tickets selling out in just five minutes.

The couple was arrested after an investigation into ticket scalping, which is when people resell tickets at higher prices. Police found a LINE chat group run by Liu and Chang, where they advertised themselves as Taiwan's biggest ticket scalping service. They were looking for helpers and tickets to resell and claimed to have

over 100 people working with them.

Their activities caught the attention of Taipei Mayor Chiang Wan-an, who ordered a crackdown on ticket scalping. The investigation showed that Liu had a criminal record for similar crimes. After questioning, Chang was released on bail of NT\$200,000, while Liu was detained because of his strange behavior. A hearing is scheduled for Friday to decide if Liu will stay in detention.

The Taipei District Prosecutors Office is examining whether Liu and Chang violated Taiwan's Development of the Cultural and Creative Industries Act, along with potential fraud and document forgery charges. This incident has led to a wider investigation into ticket scalping in Taiwan, with authorities identifying 31 scalping cases involving fake identities and bots used for fraudulent ticket purchases.
