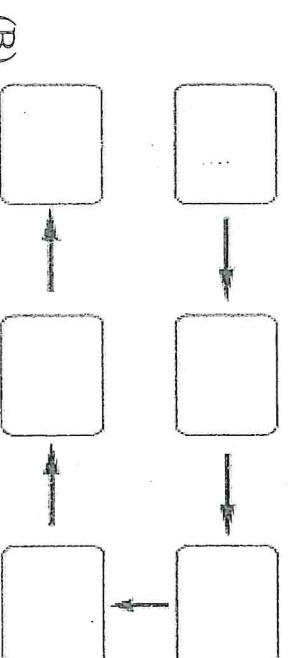
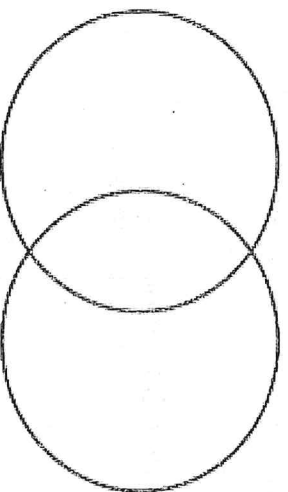

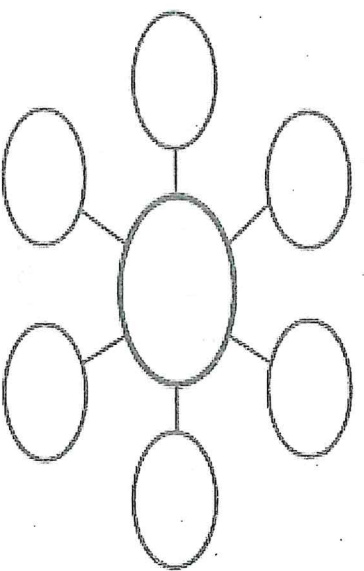
Dora volunteers to get on the train with them.

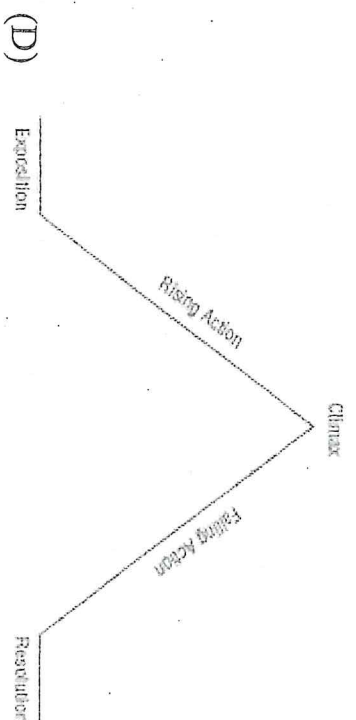
