Having Fun with Change

Most people have habits or behaviors that they would like to change for the better. However, such changes are not always easy to make. So how can we make people more eager to take action and make positive¹ changes? Fortunately, the answer, which is quite simple, is to let them have fun!

Let's look at a very common part of daily life: crossing the street. People often ignore the "red man" light signal², which tells them not to cross. This can cause accidents³. To improve⁴ road safety, a car company put up⁵ a new kind of traffic light at an intersection⁶ in Lisbon, Portugal. Instead of standing still, a new "red man" started to dance when the light turned from green to red. The red man's dance moves were actually⁶ being performed by a person in a nearby booth⁷. Anyone could enter the booth and choose the music that he or she wished to dance to. This was really fun for both the dancer and the pedestrians⁸. Thanks to this creative idea, 81% more pedestrians followed the law and stopped at the red light. It was by adding a little bit of fun to this daily routine⁹ that this experiment¹⁰ turned out to be the perfect way to make people enjoy waiting for the green light.

At a crowded subway station in Stockholm, Sweden, another fun twist¹¹ was added to daily life. An experiment was conducted¹² with the goal¹³ of having people use the stairs rather than the escalator¹⁴. In the experiment, ordinary¹⁵ stairs were changed to look like giant piano keys, and each of them would actually produce a sound when it was stepped on. Before this, people would avoid taking the stairs, going straight for the escalator. But after the change was made, many chose to climb the stairs because the giant keys looked so interesting that they were willing to do so. Some even jumped from one stair to another to play music with their feet! Guess what! The number of people who chose the stairs over the escalator went up by 66%. People were motivated¹⁶ to change their habit simply because climbing stairs was now more exciting!

People can add an exciting spark¹⁷ to their daily routines in many creative ways. When ordinary activities¹⁸ become more interesting, most people are happy to join in the fun. The rewards of these changes can be big or small; the important thing, obviously, is that they promote¹⁹ positive behavior and help to make people smile.

To see the best sights in nature, you sometimes have to put in a little extra work. Jiaming Lake, in Taitung County, is one of those sights. For many people, this mountain lake is one of the most beautiful places in Taiwan. It is 3,310 meters above sea level, and it's also the second-highest lake in Taiwan.

Jiaming Lake's oval shape and smooth surface have been appreciated by people for centuries. In Chinese, it's often compared to an angel's tear. The local Bunun people call it the "moon's mirror." They say that the moon comes to Jiaming Lake every night to look at its reflection.

On clear days, many visitors to the lake say that it looks as blue as a sapphire. However, its appearance can change a lot in different weather. In winter, the lake can turn black when it freezes. On cloudy days, gray-white fog moves over its surface. All year long, Jiaming Lake offers something unexpected to visitors.

You need to walk quite a bit to experience Jiaming Lake's magical views for yourself. The Jiaming Lake National Trail is only 13 kilometers long. However, it takes most people three days to complete it, as the trail leads hikers over two mountain peaks.

Before you put on your walking shoes, there are a couple of things you should do. First, you'll need to get official permission, as only 176 people are allowed to stay on the trail overnight. Second, consider getting a guide to take you to the top. The trail is quite tough, so it's important that you travel with an experienced hiker.

The trail will take you up more than 1,000 meters. You'll hike through tall forests and pass by lovely secret spots like Blackwater Pond. Along the way, you'll spend two nights in mountain cabins. Now, some scientists think there's a way to reduce the problem with technology that we already have: wind turbines.

Wind turbines generate electricity using the motion created by wind pushing their propellers.

Normally, this doesn't take very much energy away from the wind. If a country put enough turbines offshore, however, it could use major storms as a source of renewable power and lower the risk they pose at the same time. A team of engineers in the US has calculated that by reducing wind strength, offshore turbines could save areas near the ocean from flooding. While the turbines wouldn't completely prevent floods, the water could be brought down to a less serious level. Many cities in the southeastern US are on the coast and are often at the risk of damage from hurricanes. That makes this proposed initiative attractive to states like Louisiana, Texas, and Florida.

The engineers estimated that the power of hurricanes could be greatly reduced by means of an offshore set of thousands of turbines. This number is much larger than even the current largest offshore wind farm, though. For that reason, the team doesn't expect this idea to be fully realized. Rather, they proposed the project in order to encourage future research. The number of wind farms in the world may increase significantly in the future. When that happens, such research could be very important. Understanding more about the way wind turbines interact with the weather patterns around them will help engineers pick out the

best places to put them.
