

Most animals have fur or feathers to protect themselves from the sun's rays; however, hairless animals are particularly at risk of sunburn. It's no surprise, (56), that many of these animals have developed their own adaptations to protect their skin. Pigs like to roll in the mud to prevent their skin from being damaged from (57) sunlight. Elephants throw sand on their backs and heads for use (58) a kind of natural sunblock. Hippos have developed a physical adaptation—they produce a red-colored substance around their eyes and ears that acts as a natural sunscreen by absorbing ultraviolet light. Whales, which spend a lot of time at the ocean surface, can (59) sunburn, too. So it's a good thing that blue whales have a special adaptation that allows their cells to (60) skin damage and prevents them from getting skin cancer easily.


